The Compliance manager shall be the nominated company Health & Safety Officer, who shall be accessible to all employees for consultation regarding OH&S concerns or suggestions and ensure their representation at management review meetings.

It is a mandatory requirement of all employees to conduct their activities in accordance with defined management system requirements and behave at all times in a manner which will not put themselves, colleagues or other persons at risk of injury or ill health.
